

DEF Is Here!
Emission Standards Begin Jan. 1st

In 2000 and 2001, EPA published the Tier 2 Emission Standards for Light Duty and Heavy Duty Vehicles, mandating that on-highway diesel and gasoline vehicles meet new strict emission control standards **beginning January 1, 2010.** Effective that date, no new on-road vehicles can be sold without meeting the Tier 2 emission standard: 0.2 grams of nitrogen oxide (NOx) per brake horsepower-hour.

Code Status of DEF

EPA says "not hazardous", exempting UST or AST storage from regulations

NFPA says "not explosive", exempt from combustible regulations

Weights and Measures say, "if you sell it, it must be metered by weights and measures, and approved meter"

Starts to freeze at 13 degrees Fahrenheit

Will begin to degrade at 80 degrees

Stainless steel is the preferred metal for compatibility

DEF consumption 2.5% of Diesel Fuel

Estimated mileage for municipal diesel vehicles
10,000 miles per year at 6 miles per gallon =
41.6 gallons of DEF
